### **Michael Thomas Sullivan - Wantagh, NY Freshman - Penn State University**

At the age of 9, Michael began recovering surplus food after concerts, wedding receptions and company parties with the organization Rock and Wrap It Up. Once he learned to drive, he organized a program to pick up surplus food after sporting events at Nassau Coliseum and drive it to local shelters. Now at college, Michael continues his philanthropic efforts by rescuing surplus food from campus and donating it. Since the sixth grade he has helped make sandwiches for the needy with members of his church's outreach program, helping to serve 8,000 hot meals and making 18,000 sandwiches for hungry people.
